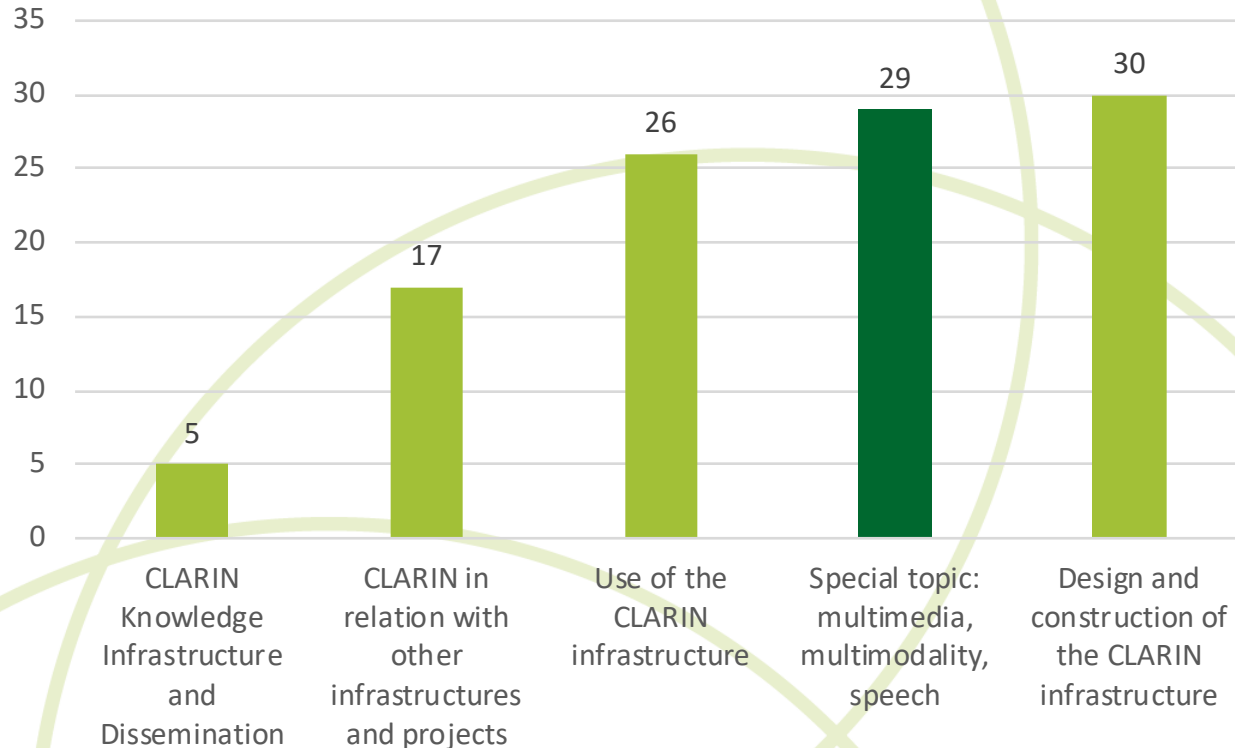

CLARIN 2018 review process

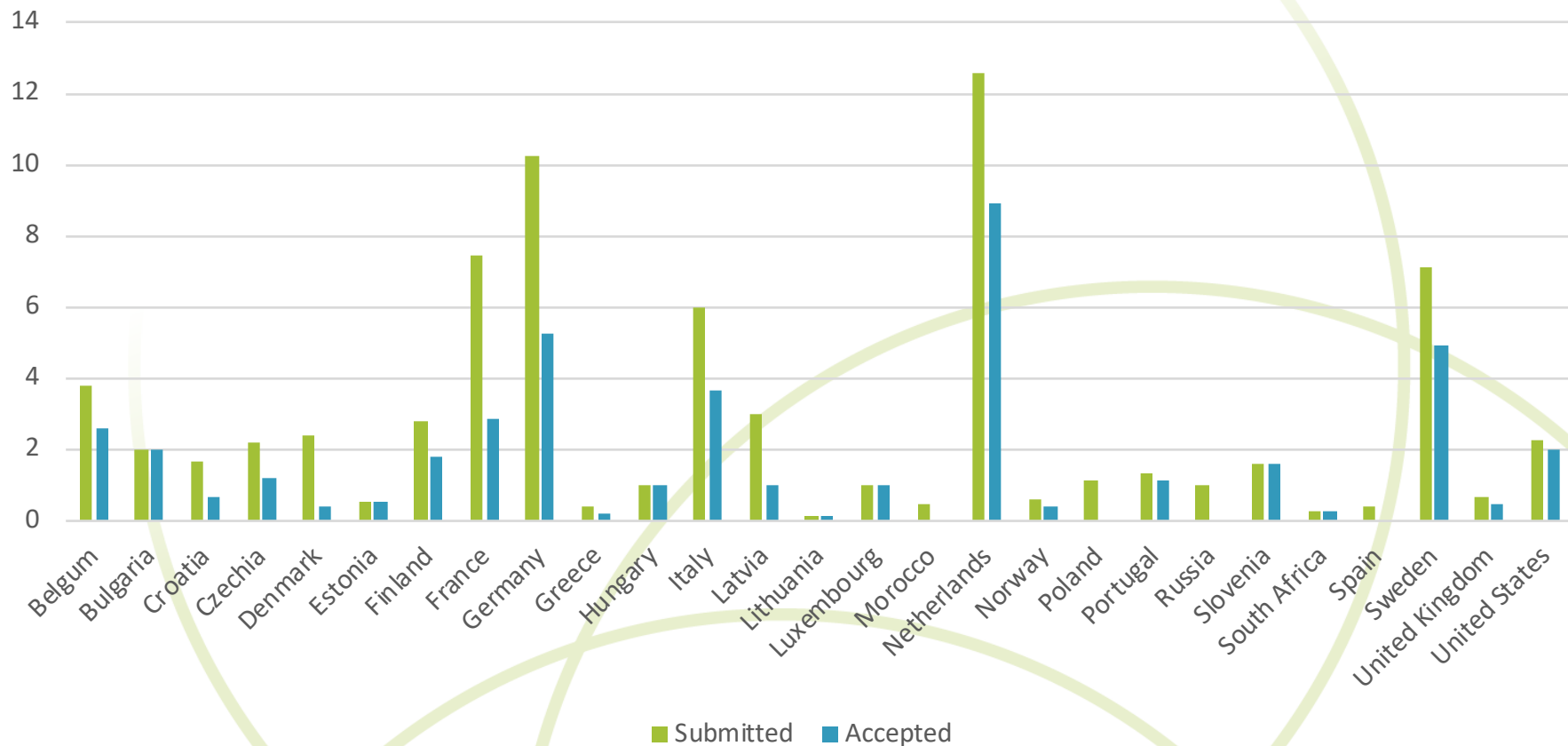
- 74 abstracts submitted

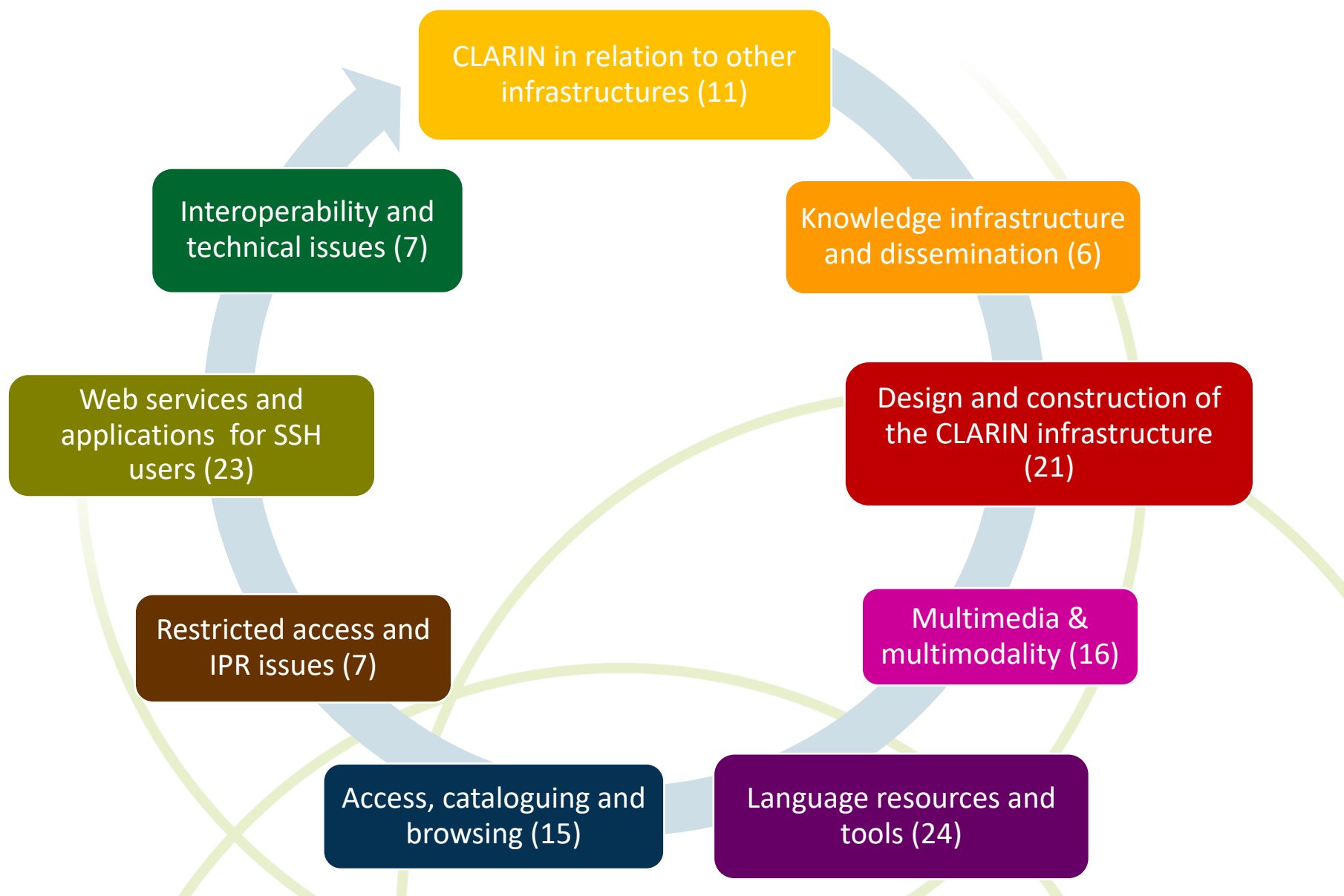
